Personal data that we process.

Mpilo Foundation processes your personal data because you use our services and / or because you provide them to us yourself.

Below you will find an overview of the personal data we process:

- First and last name
- E-mail address
- Bank account number

Special and / or sensitive personal data that we process.

Our website and / or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors under the age of 16. Unless they have parental or guardian permission. However, we cannot check whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore recommend that parents be involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children from being collected without parental consent. For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data.

Mpilo Foundation processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Handling your payment.
- Sending our newsletter and / or advertising brochure.
- To be able to call or e-mail you, if this is necessary to carry out our services.

How long we keep personal data.

The Mpilo Foundation does not store your personal data longer than is strictly necessary to realize the goals for which your data is collected. We use the following retention periods for the following (categories) of personal data:

- retention period for personal details and email address regarding newsletter: during the term of the free subscription.

Sharing personal data with third parties.

Mpilo Foundation does not sell your data to third parties and only provides it if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. We conclude a processor agreement with companies that process your data on our behalf to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. The Mpilo Foundation remains responsible for these processing operations.

Cookies, or comparable techniques, that we use.

The Mpilo Foundation uses only technical and functional cookies. And analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and, for example, remember your preferred settings. We can also optimize our website with this. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information previously saved via the settings of your browser.

View, adjust or delete data.

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by the Mpilo Foundation and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data that we hold about you in a computer file to you or another organization mentioned by you. You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for cancellation of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to info@mpilofoundation.com. To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your ID with the request. Make your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and citizen service number (BSN) black in this copy. This is to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within four weeks. The Mpilo Foundation also wants to point out that you have the opportunity to file a complaint with the national supervisory authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
